Artist Statement | Through her attention to detail, Kit Paulson creates intricate designs that often draw upon themes of perception and what influences our perspective. Using borosilicate glass, her work ranges from wearable objects such as crowns and goggles to decorative pieces such as candle holders and miniature sculptures. "Things that are intricate and clearly time-consuming appeal to me," said Paulson. "Each tiny piece is, for a moment, the entire focus of one person's attention. When you look at the piece you are seeing that intense build-up of collected attention."
