Artist Statement | So much of what I do as a professional metalworker is about problem-solving efficiently and quickly, accurately working to budget and schedule. In contrast, the inflated pieces are unpredictable and exploratory. I'm fascinated by the rigid geometry of the starting structure unfolding and expanding into unforeseen wrinkles and graceful, soft surfaces, frozen in space after the material cools.
